# The demonstration of making a blowgun using the AVerVision visualizer is well received at the Taipei City Zoo

In order to protect the fire fighters and to prevent them from maiming the innocents during the capture of stray animals, Taipei City Zoo held a series of courses on how to make tranquilizer guns and blowguns. AVerVision visualizer was used as the medium to giving a vivid and vigorous demonstration.

Whether it is making a blowgun or a tranquilizer gun, the parts used are rather small. In the past, students used to gather around the teacher to see how they are made, but the sight was easily blocked by another student and they were not able to follow the teacher step by step. Usually, the teacher had to repeat him- or herself to students who didn't get a clear view of the procedure the first time, thus making the teaching process inefficient. Thanks to AVerVision visualizer, the cutting and fixing of the yarn at the end of the blowgun and the exact spot to inserting the needle tube are vividly captured live. The students need not to leave their seats and the whole making process is enlarged and clearly shown on a big screen. Not only the effort in teaching has decreased, the learning

process has become much more efficient. "The AVerVision visualizer has greatly improved the outcome of the course by displaying the enlarged details of the step by step making of the blowgun. Students can simultaneously follow teacher's instructions, making the learning process much more efficient," commented Mr. Zhihua Zhang, the lecturer and Director of Veterinary Division, Taipei City Zoo.

Other than displaying processes in real-time, AVerVision visualizer also comes with the versatile AVerVision software that plays an important role in the course.
